Learning Objectives: To recognise different sound sources

Learning Outcomes: Identify different sound sources

Start by asking the pupils to listen out for different sounds that they can hear in the classroom; are there any sounds they can hear coming from outside the classroom, make a list on a board. Go to slide 2 which will give you sixteen 'Every Day Sounds', from outside, in the home etc.

Play the links to the different 'Every Day Sounds' and ask the pupils to put the correct number (1 to 8) in the boxes on WORKSHEET 1 of all the sounds they hear. Make sure no one shouts out the answer. You could then make a list on the board and compare the answers given for each sound. This will develop listening, memory skills and writing the numbers 1 to 8. Wait until the end of each sound before you click for the next, this will give the pupils time to listen and put the number in the box. Play the sounds again, and ask the pupils to describe whether they are; High/Low, loud/quiet, long/short, now and then or all the time.
